Dear Secretary Bose;

Please accept this filing on behalf of the Town of Roseboom. At our November Board meeting a resolution was unanimously passed to reiterate the requests of our sister Towns, Villages and County. It is important to note that we are not asking for the Dominion New Market Brookman Corners Compressor Station Expansion Project to be halted, just modified to use the safest and least polluting equipment available. The topography of the area demands it. The farming Amish and Mennonite families living off their land deserve it. At the time of the scoping hearings, no effort was made to accommodate their culture by having a hearing nearby where they could voice their concerns. Despite several requests to FERC by five Town and Village Boards, the closest hearings to Brookman Corners were over two hours away by car.

Though the people living in the Town of Minden will be the first to suffer the severest effects of the toxic emissions from the expanded compressor station, the entire region's air quality will also be affected unless the requested equipment modifications are installed.
